EXPIRATION DATE EXTENSIONS

Due to the upcoming implementation of the Division of Motor Vehicles' new computer system, RIMS, on July 5, 2017, the Division of Motor Vehicles hereby exercises its authority, pursuant to P.L. 2017, ch. 097 and P.L. 2017, ch. 098, to extend the following expiration dates:

- All Rhode Island drivers' licenses and identification cards set to expire between July 1, 2017 and July 31, 2017 shall now expire on September 30, 2017.
- All Rhode Island registrations set to expire on July 31, 2017 shall now expire on September 30, 2017.
- All Rhode Island special use identification tags issued by motor vehicle dealers ("temporary plates") between July 1, 2017 and July 31, 2017 shall be valid for up to 40 days from the date of issuance.
- Rhode Island residents who purchase a motor vehicle from Rhode Island motor
 vehicle dealers, out-of-state motor vehicle dealers, or private parties between July
 1, 2017 and July 31, 2017 shall have up to 40 days to register the vehicle if the
 purchaser's prior motor vehicle and the newly purchased motor vehicle are of the
 same type and the registration plates from the purchaser's prior motor vehicle
 will be transferred to the newly purchased motor vehicle.
