20	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are		
21	matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and		
22			
23	WHEREAS, the School Committee has cut funding for, among other things, academic		
24	programs, after school activities, school sports programs, elementary school teacher assistants,		
25	custodial staff and accreditation for the 2019-2020 school year; and		
26	WHEREAS the City Council does not serve with the School Committee's decision to out		
27	WHEREAS, the City Council does not agree with the School Committee's decision to cut these programs and positions listed as priority items No. 1 through No. 17 in the School		
28 29	these programs and positions listed as priority items No.1 through No. 17 in the School Committee's June 18, 2019 adopted proposed cuts, attached hereto as an exhibit, from their		
29 30	adopted budget for the 2019-2020 school year; and		
31	adopted budget for the 2017 2020 senoor year, and		
32	WHEREAS, the City Council is aware that the City and the School Committee continue		
33	to engage in mediation to determine the need, or lack thereof, for additional funding for the		
34	2019-2020 academic year; and

36	WHEREAS, the School Committee has represented that an additional \$1.3 Million is		
37	necessary to fund school sports in the 2019-2020 school year; and

39	WHEREAS, it is the belief of the City Council that all parties are interested in funding		
40	these programs and positions for the upcoming school year in a timely manner to avoid the		
41	hardships and scheduling issues that would occur if resolution of this matter does not happen		
42	immediately; and		
43			
44	WHEREAS, the Warwick City Council commits through this Resolution that it will		
45	appropriate the necessary additional funds, including, an additional \$1.3 Million Dollars, to the		

1	School Department for fiscal year 20	020 for funding of priority items No. 1 through No. 17 on the	
2	attached exhibit, provided that the W	Varwick School Committee first commits, through a duly	
3	adopted Resolution of the School Committee, that all of the said newly appropriated funds will		
4	be used for, and only for, priority items No. 1 through No. 17 on the attached exhibit; and

6	WHEREAS, it is the belief of the City Council that all parties agree that the current		
7	funding situation for the School Committee is not sustainable, thus the School Committee must		
8	also commit to duly adopting a Resolution stating it will conduct a thorough review of each of its		
9	budgeted line items in comparison to comparable districts, such as Cranston, and to prepare a		
10	detailed report of such, which it will disseminate to the City Council at least six (6) months prior		
11	to submitting its proposed budget fo	r the 2020-2021 academic year; and	
12			
13	WHEREAS, the School Committee must also commit to duly adopt a Resolution, based		
14	on the above referenced review, to develop a plan of action to reduce expenditures, and will		
15	prepare a detailed report of such, which it will disseminate to the City Council at least four (4)		
16	months prior to submitting its propo	sed budget for the 2020-2021 academic year; and	
17			
18	WHEREAS, the School Committee must also commit to allow for the City Council to		
19	participate in the entirety of the process for both the above stated review and the development of		
20	a plan of action, without limitation.
