## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF THREE MILLION NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTYFOUR DOLLARS FOR THE WARWICK SCHOOLS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019 AND AUTHORIZING REPAYMENT FOR THE DEFICIT IN THE FISCAL YEAR THAT ENDED ON JUNE 30, 2019

2	Resolved that,		
3			
4	WHEREAS, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Warwick are		
5	matters of paramount importance to the City Council; and		
6			
7	WHEREAS, there has been a long running disagreement between the Warwick School		
8	Committee and the City over the question of whether the School Committee has adequate		
9	funding for the Warwick School Department for fiscal years2018-2019 and fiscal year 2019-		
10	2020; and		
11			
12	WHEREAS, the Warwick School Committee asserted that it needed an additional \$4		
13	Million for the fiscal year that ended June 30, 2019 and has asserted that it needed \$7.7 Million		
14	in additional funding for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the City have denied that the additional		
15	funding was necessary for either fiscal year;		
16			
17	WHEREAS, the City Council and the Warwick School Committee desire to resolve the		
18	funding issues for the two fiscal years; and		
19			
20	WHEREAS, Section 5-23 of the Warwick City Charter entitled "Emergency		
21	Appropriations" provides that:		
22			
23	At any time in any fiscal year, the council may make emergency appropriations to		
24	meet a pressing need for public expenditure, for other than a regular or recurring		
25	requirement, to protect the public health, safety, or welfare. Such appropriation shall		
26	be by resolution adopted by the favorable votes of at least five (5) members of the		
27	council, and shall be made only upon recommendation of the mayor.; and

29	WHEREAS, within the parameters set forth herein, the City Council and the Mayor has		
30	recommended that:		

31		1. That the \$4 Million needed by the School Department to fund the deficit in fiscal year
32		2018-2019 be repaid to the City without interest at \$1 Million per year commencing
33		July 1, 2019; and
34	/	2. A supplemental appropriation of Three Million Nine Hundred Eighty-five Thousand
35		Four Hundred Seventy-four (\$3,985,474.00) Dollars be made to the School
36		Department by the City for the fiscal year 2019-2020 to fund items No. 1 through No.
37		17 on the Exhibit attached hereto with the money being drawn from the City's funds
38		as follows:
39		\$1,000,000 from the contingency line item;
40		\$1,000,000 from the City's Fund Balance;
41		\$1,085,474 from the road paving line item;

44		WITEDEAS, the negative for this renextment and supplemental engeneriction are the

47		1. The Warwick School Committee and the City will execute mutual releases
48		acknowledging that the repayment terms stated herein and the supplemental
49		appropriation described herein are in full settlement of any and all claims that the
50		School Committee has for additional funding for fiscal years 2018-2019 and 2019-
51		2020; and
52	-	2. The Warwick School Committee will conduct a thorough review of each of its
53		budgeted line items in comparison to comparable districts, such as Cranston, and to
54		prepare a detailed report of such, which it will disseminate to the City Council at least
55		six (6) months prior to submitting its proposed budget for the 2020-2021 academic
56		year; and
57		3. The Warwick School Committee will develop a plan of action to reduce expenditures,
58		and will prepare a detailed report of such, which it will disseminate to the City
59		Council at least four (4) months prior to submitting its proposed budget for the 2020-
60		2021 academic year; and
61	4	4. The Warwick School Committee will allow the City Council or its designated
62		representatives to participate in the entirety of the process for both the above stated
63		review and the development of a plan of action, without limitation.

65		WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the above referenced repayment and
66	supplen	nental appropriation to the Warwick School Department for the fiscal year ending June
67	30, 201	9 and for the fiscal year that commenced on July 1, 2019 should be approved.
